spot whole and undefiled it means that

Isaac was to me Jacob was very not to

matured king David had to walk through

the process of being to me to me is

added to it the proper kneading the

proper rising the proper heat the proper

tribulation and then out comes this

incredible loaf of bread that's worthy

for the high priest to wave before

Yahweh himself this is the spiritual

journey that all of us are on my friends

we are all on the journey of going from

salvation which is what i believe

Passover is connected to of course uh

Yeshua dies on the cross and creates the

opportunity for the veil to be rent and

the holy of holies to be open and for

salvation to come to all man but that is
