You Won't Believe Who The False Prophet Is!

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We've talked about the Antichrist, what 666 really means, the mark of the beast, Babylon, the beast. Now we're going to finish this series with the false prophet and the image of the beast. What does all that really look like? AI can drastically help us in this process, and it actually can be the demon at the same time. We're going to talk about it, unpack it. Don't miss this episode. It's the last one in our AI end of the world series right after this.

We've talked about Babylon, who that is. We've talked about the beast, the woman that's riding the beast, the second beast, the Antichrist, what 666 really means, and the mark of the beast. We've talked about so much. If you haven't seen those [previous three episodes](#), I encourage you to check them out. They will definitely intrigue you, I believe, and educate you from exactly what AI is in the very beginning, first episode, the three types of AIs, AGI, ASI, narrow AOI. Where are we at right now? Where's it going? Where should we be concerned? Is AI evil? Should Christians use it? And then how does it fit into the entire end time scene? That's what we've been talking about, and that's what we're going to finish up today.

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This ministry, by the way, if you're new to this ministry, this is not our typical MO is to dive into everything in times. My expertise is in first century early Christianity, Judaism, Hebraic thoughts, idiomatic expressions, the language, the culture, the context. We go verse by verse in the scriptures and we unpack them from the original author's perspective. And so, when we do that, we radically can come to different conclusions than what 21st century Western Christianity has devised because they're going through a lens of Western Greco-Roman mindset. And we need to go from the author's mindset, and they were all Hebrew. When we do that, we can really discover some amazing things. So, if that's the type of channel you're looking for, please subscribe to this channel. And without further ado, let's begin with this week's topic. We're going to talk about the false prophet and the image of the beast. What is the false prophet? Who is the false prophet? Can we

possibly know? What does it look like? Should we even know? Should we be looking into these things? That's what we're going to talk about. We're going to find out and let's do it right now.

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First of all, we have the first beast. It is like the crown on top of all the king's heads. It has all the authority, all the kings give it its authority, and it uses Babylon, which is a city state that has phenomenal territorial growth globally. Everyone wants to do business with Babylon. There is a lot of attraction to joining that system. The beast uses Babylon to get everybody on the same page and then begins the process of making it mandatory. And that's where the first beast comes in. The second beast is the false prophet. It's kind of the religious section or religious arm of the Antichrist that's going to be ruling the world at this time.

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And again, it's very important that everybody knows this is not something that you just like you just you get into and you discover the names you discover who they are you can find out the number and know exactly all of that happens after the fact this is going to be a slow boil where most of us are not even going to know that we're inside of the Babylonian system inside of the beast mouth until it already happens and this is why knowing the pattern is what John is talking about on the island of Patmos when he has this vision. He wants us to know and observe and discern the pattern that's going on. So, where the first beast, again, focuses totally on allegiance through force, the false prophet's going to do this through verbal coercion. He's going to explain that the system is good. Compliance is responsible. Resistance is dangerous, and dissent is totally immoral. This is going to be the arm of the Antichrist that's going to get a lot of people to bow, is the prophet, and this is important.

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So, the prophet, where does he come from? He rises, first of all, from within the system. He's not going to come from without. He's going to rise up from within the system, which means, I believe, it's happening in our lifetime, that he's already alive, he's already being groomed, it's a matter of time. He's going to come from the religious sector of the system for sure. And he's going to be ratified and well accepted by almost all religious leaders that are out there that people will listen to him because of that. So that means it's probably going to be some generic across all religion borders. That's going to be well spoken. He's going to get the tap from the Antichrist or the beast, the first beast. It could be ratified, not necessarily by the Antichrist himself, but by a group of individuals or a UN type of authority.

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Let me ask, what is the purpose of the false prophet? The purpose of the false prophet is to make allegiance to the beast feel righteous, not coerced. So, my guess is the way scripture happens on the timeline here is that most of the people

are going to join Babylon because it's just going to be so alerting, so easy, and I believe that's happening as we speak. I think the whole entire digital world is moving into the Babylon system. It is definitely going to be used by the Antichrist. And then all of a sudden, it's going to not be voluntary anymore. It is going to be mandatory. Then there's going to be probably pushback. And then that would be the great opportunity for the false prophet to come forward and to make it to where, hey guys, we need to do this. This is for unity, morally obligation. You know, he's going to create that guilt and that peer pressure mentality that really works under pressure. He's going to make things sound normal before they're mandatory. All right. And he's going to frame resistance without a doubt as dangerous and selfish or even immoral. And I believe he's going to prepare the world psychologically and morally for the image and the mark, because that's what's coming next. The image and the mark come after the Antichrist and the false prophet, and I believe it's his job to absolutely set the stage for that. He's going to move people from this total voluntary participation phase to the unquestioned, absolute obedience phase. That is going to be his role.

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Now, what's important for all of us to know is all of this is about function, not identity. From **Revelation 13** and related passages, the false prophet is defined by function, not identity. And this is why those that focus to try to figure out who the false prophet is, to figure out who the Antichrist is, they miss the point of what John is trying to say. He's not trying to tell us who the Antichrist necessarily is in our age. He's trying to show us through first century Rome, which it was Nero who had the number 666. We know it's Nero; we know Rome was the original Babylon, and the beast comes out of that. So, he's trying to tell us this is what the pattern is going to look like. We look at Rome in the first century, and that's going to tell us what the template should describe in our day and age, or in the very end times, okay? He appears like a lamb, but he's going to be using moral, benevolent, righteous language, yet he's going to speak like a dragon. He's going to use dragon logic by legitimizing authority divorced from God. He's going to absolutely tap back the one that's tapped him, which is going to give legitimacy to the Antichrist because people are going to trust this false prophet and he's going to validate the authority.

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Now, I will tell you without a doubt that the church is so ripe for falling prey to this because they're going to say, oh, the Bible tells us to submit to all authority. And I'm telling you; I heard pastors during COVID times that were telling us we need to submit to the government, we need to take the vaccine, you need to do everything you need to do, Because the government's telling God tells us to obey the government. I'm telling you it's coming down the pipe where pastors that don't know their Bible God bless their hearts, but they don't know the original context that was written in or what the scriptures are actually trying to say and they're going to lead people right into the jaws of The Antichrist through the false prophet and the image which coming which we'll talk about next. This false prophet is

going to frame Allegiance to the system as good necessary, compassionate, responsible.

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He's going to say, he's going to use all kinds of signs and wonders. He's going to fall upon his expertise. His credibility to persuade the masses will be unmatched. He'll move people towards compliance, not by force, but by moral reasoning. And this is where people are very vulnerable. We've seen that in the past through epidemics and how easy it is to manipulate the sheep. That role does not have to be filled by a single individual, my friends. It can be carried by an institution, a coalition, or even a group of individuals. So just like Rome, let's talk about this because it really is just like Rome. We need to look at Rome because Rome is what John and all of his readers would have known that he was talking about. They just didn't know that there was going to be a pattern that's going to be set for thousands of years later and Rome is the template for that.

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Rome did not rely on one imperial priest or prophet, but an entire system of legitimizers. This is why naming someone early misses the point. When believers focus on who the false prophet is, they will miss what he's saying, how persuasion works, and why compliance feels righteous. Historically, people did not fall because they trusted a villain, but because they trusted credible voices telling them that obedience was responsible, necessary, peaceful, safe, and unifying. That is the language of the false prophet. And we saw this during the world epidemic just a few years ago. We see this.

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Why? Because experts with credentials were telling us, this is what you need to do. They were using emergency language. They moralized compliance, shaming people that didn't fall into alignment, that didn't get the jab, that required more research, testing, they didn't want to be guinea pigs on something that had never been used before, and they literally made them like they were ostracized, moral outcasts, like they hated children. There were social consequences for dissent. Language of protection, responsibility, we saw all of this during those times. That was just the shot across the bow, ladies and gentlemen. The real, real time where this is going to all be used in extreme levels is during the time of the false prophet, the Antichrist, and we're going to be here. Whether people think it or not, we're going to be here for this. We need to be ready for this. Never in God's timing did God's people just resurrect from trial. No, we're called to endure through trial. Blessed are those who endure. James even says, consider it pure joy to face trials of many kinds. We are set up from the very beginning to go through the fire to purify us. In Revelation 13, 14, and 15, the second beast, later identified as the false prophet, he causes the image of the beast to be made. Now let's move on to the image. We've talked about the false prophet. What his job is going to be is going to be that moral unifier, almost like the coach on the sideline. So the second beast, which is the false prophet, he causes an image of the beast to be made.

It's given authority to give breath to that image. The image speaks and it causes those who refuse to worship it to be killed.

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Now, just to be fair, in Hebrew thought, worship does not have to mean deity. It simply means to bow the knee and give honor to. So, when you bow the knee to a king in English, you could say that you worshiped that king. Even though in English the word worship almost always is referring to a deity, it does not have to mean a deity at all. It simply means that you are conceding to that authority. You are honoring that authority above God. You're giving it that much honor. I'm telling you, there are going to be Christians alive during this time period. They're never going to know that they're giving more honor to that image than they are to God because they've not prepared for what that looks like. They've not been taught or their heart and mind hasn't been in alignment with what scripture says to know that they've already bowed the knee.

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From the text alone, the image is intentionally constructed. It's animated with delegated authority. It's fully capable of total communication, and it's capable of enforcement simultaneously. It's not the beast itself, or the Antichrist. It's the representation through which the beast will exercise his authority. And this is where AI is going to come in, my friends. So, hold on, because I'm going to show you exactly where I believe this is going. Scripture doesn't say that the image becomes human. When it says breath, *pneuma*, in the Greek, that consistently refers to animating force. When you have a pneumatic drill, it doesn't mean that it's alive, a human. It just means that it is run by air. It is moving. There are parts that move. It has authorization. It has operational capacity. In other words, the image is empowered to act. A first century reader would have understood this as the empire has given its representation and authority to speak and decide. That's what they would have interpreted as. The beast is the system, but the image is how the system shows up everywhere. The image speaks the policies, renders the judgments, distinguishes compliance from resistance, triggers all the consequences of cancel culture. It makes authority present, immediate, everywhere, and unavoidable.

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Ladies and gentlemen, there's nothing else on the planet that could do this but AI. When it reaches super intelligence, you're not going to have riots anymore in the streets. You know why? Because just the facial recognition alone of cameras everywhere will immediately be able to detect who those people are, what they're doing, and they will immediately be locked out of the system. They won't even be able to buy bread the next day. They'll be indicted, and the police will be on their door, and they'll be in a jail the very next day. That's how quick it will happen.

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Now, the original image going back to Rome was Nero. There were imperial statues everywhere, imperial edicts. Caesar's image was on coinage. The emperor's presence carried through decrees. They would simply show you the statue and you had to bow because the statue itself represented the authority that was behind it. This is why God says you're not allowed to make an image of Him on the earth. He didn't want people bowing to images. He wanted people bowing in their heart to Him. So, what's the modern image of the beast need? It needs to represent centralized authority. It needs to speak with delegated legitimacy. It makes decisions at global scale and it enforces compliance consistently. It operates continuously across society. And that description, my friends, aligns functionally, not symbolically. And I'm telling you, it's going to happen with ASI, which is artificial superintelligence.

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Now let's talk about the breakdown of the image of the beast because I find as kind of a first century focus on the Bible and especially the front of the book, what I call the front of the book, the Old Testament, and how it affects the back of the book, when I hear the image of the beast, immediately I hear of the image of God. It's a mockery of God's image. And I immediately think of Genesis, which is humanity made in God's image. And I think of the Torah, which is the prohibition against images made for worship. The enemy, the dragon, Satan, Lucifer, whatever you want to call him, he's literally taking the beginning in the garden and he's mocking the garden at the end.

So, let's go to **Genesis 1** and let's read this verse. It says in **verse 26 and 27**,

Genesis 1

"²⁶...let us make man in our image, according to our likeness, and let them have dominion."

-NKJV

So, from the very beginning, God's intention in His heart was that we would be made after His image, that we would have His heart, that we would reflect His glory, that we would bow the knee to His edicts, that we would revolve our world around Him, and He would be our sustenance.

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When you get to **Exodus 20**, which is what I mentioned earlier, the section of the Ten Commandments, it says in **verse 4 and 5**,

Exodus 20

“⁴You shall not make for yourself a carved image... ⁵you shall not bow down to them...”

-NKJV

Now, I don't know how many scholars or those that deal in eschatology and end-time study have made this connection, but in the Ten Commandments itself, It's warning us of the image of the beast. This is why you're not allowed to make a carved image. In ancient times, they knew that you could not directly worship a god. You couldn't. The gods never communicated directly with humans. They went through a medium, and that medium would be a wooden statue covered in gold, silver, or what have you. The palm-sized ones were called teraphim. You put them in your pockets, and if you were going to plow, you would take the god that was for agriculture, put it in your pocket, and it would bring you a blessing. That's what they would think. They never believed that you could go directly to the gods.

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This is why, coming out of Egypt, they built a golden calf. It wasn't they were trying to worship the golden calf. They were worshiping Yahweh, but they were doing it through a new medium because they lost Moses. They didn't think he was ever coming back. That's why Aaron says in the text, he says, tomorrow is a feast unto Yahweh. And for some of you, that's a mind-blowing thought concept because you were always taught that they were worshiping another god. If you've been a part of this ministry for any length of time, I've told that a million times, but that's only from God's perspective. He says, Moses, get out of my way. They're in idolatry. But from their perspective, which is our perspective, man always thinks it's doing the right thing. We always seem to think that we can worship God how we want. And that doesn't go over well very much sometimes. So we can think we're doing the right thing and worshiping God, but from God's perspective, it can be idolatry. But He says in Exodus, don't make a carved image. He's setting it up. I don't want you to look to anything on this earth to bow even in my name. You bow in your heart to me in my ways that I wrote down. And I think this is why it is so important that we understand why He wrote His instruction manual down. It's called the Word of God. It's called the Torah. It's called the instructions. It's called the Law of God.

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This is what Paul says in Romans 3:31. He says, just because Christ came or faith came, does that mean the Law of God is made void? May it never be. I uphold the Law of God. The reason why God's Word has to be upheld. And the reason why the enemy for 2,000 years has pulled the wool over the Christian church's mind, I should say for 1,800 years, 1,700 years since Constantine in the fourth century, is because he doesn't want us to have anything solid to follow. He

knows he's setting up the system for the beast and the false prophet to give instructions that are religiously based to even Serve God, but outside of His Word. It's going to sound good. It's going to feel good. It's even going to touch you to your soul and even make you feel like you're pleasing Him more. And in the process, you'll be eating from the tree the knowledge of good and evil again.

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Because this is the same pattern in the original trick in the garden. What did he say? God didn't really mean that He doesn't want you to be wise. Don't you want to be wise? In order to be wise and please God, you have to eat of this tree. It will make you wise, which is what God really wants. You can love Him more. You know that was the conversation. The text says it. This is what caused the deception and I believe this will be the great deception at the end of time is the false prophet is going to lead people down a road to make them feel like they are loving God, obeying Him, but because he already set it up for 1,800 years almost, that God's word is irrelevant, it's illegitimate, you don't need the Torah, you don't need the principles that are found in the front of the book, then he will make his own and people will do whatever seems right to them in their own eyes and it will lead to death.

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They will have no idea that they are sinning because they've been taught by pastors and very well-meaning people in ministry that the Word of God, the law of God, is irrelevant. So, the moment you get rid of the law of God, you get rid of the definition of sin, which is the transgression of God's law. [1 John 3:4](#). And if you get rid of the definition of sin, then there is no transgression. There's no need for a Savior because there's no condemnation that could come from breaking the law. So, if it doesn't exist and we don't have to keep it, then we are not breaking anything. We can't be condemned. We don't need a Savior. The whole gospel falls apart, which is exactly the venom of the snake. And I'm fired up about this because coming to the false prophet is connecting to prophetic voices like myself and other people that are doing their best to teach the Word in its entirety, raw, unfiltered, unadulterated. Back in the first century, this is what it means. I'm sorry if it offends you, but we need to get in line with the Word of God. Because the false prophet is going to tell you the opposite. He's going to tell you that you can do these things, that God's Word didn't mean what He said. And I'm here to tell you that Jesus Christ, Yeshua the Messiah, is the Word of God, made flesh, [John 1:14](#). He meant what He said. He wrote the commandments. He was and is fully God manifested in the flesh. He wrote it. He meant it. He expects us to do it.

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Why? Because there's going to come a time when the false prophet's going to show up and he's going to deceive the entire world because he set it up as the entire front of the book is irrelevant. And I'm telling you, the entire front of the book is the foundation blueprint to make it through the end days. Without it, we will be stuck in our own sin. And that's why in [Revelation 12:17](#), it says that the

beast goes after who? He didn't go after people that believe in Jesus. He doesn't. He goes after, it says, those who hold to the testimony of Christ and keep the commandments of God. Those are the ones that have power in the end days. Those are the ones that can navigate around all of His lies because they can find chapter and verse where those who just believe in Christ don't have just chapter and verse because they believe half of it's not even relevant to them, so the beast will be easily able to deceive them, just like he did Adam and Eve in the garden.

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All right, my friends, that was a small diatribe. Let's talk about Christ. He is the true image. [Colossians 1:15](#) declares that Christ is the image of the invisible God. [Hebrews 1:3](#) clarifies that He's the exact representation of His nature, meaning Christ is not an image that is made, but the image that's revealed. According to Revelation, the beast is going to make a image, but Christ is the revealed image. He doesn't merely reflect God, but shares in God's very nature, which means His authority is inherent rather than assigned. As the true image, He restores humanity to its intended role as image bearers, which is what our job is, which is why the New Testament never speaks of believers as images of Christ. We reflect His image. He embodies the image of His Father.

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In Revelation, the false prophet, he causes the image to be made, which is the opposite. He gives breath to the image because that's what God did to Adam as the image. This image is going to speak. The image enforces obedience. This is not accidental language. It's a counter-creation narrative. This is redoing the Garden of Eden. In Genesis, God breathed life into man, and that breath produced a living being with conscious relationship and moral agency. In Revelation, the false prophet gives breath to the image of the beast, yet the scripture is careful never to say that the image becomes alive. It becomes operational. That distinction is crucial as we move into superintelligence and general intelligence technology. What I'm saying right now is going to make all the difference in the world. This breath is without life. Animation without personhood. Does it sound familiar? The image can think without conscience, speak without relationship, judge without mercy, and enforce without accountability.

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What emerges is authority detached from human. It's detached from personhood. It's power severed from moral responsibility. That's not a minor detail, my friends. That's the nightmare that Revelation is warning us about. And you know what I believe that it possibly could be? The only thing that all technology points to right now is an embodied AI robot. The image of the beast is not the beast itself. It's an animated representation of its authority. In the first century, that looked like imperial images and decrees. Today, it would look like an image of the Antichrist that can speak, decide, and enforce loyalty everywhere at once. And AI is the only tool that's capable of doing exactly that. Now, I don't know exactly what it's

going to look like, but no question, at the end of the day, superintelligence is going to have access and is going to be a part of this.

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So, in the end, my friends, it is our responsibility to make sure that we are holding the image of God because we are the last light bearers on earth and the next generation has barely learned anything about the Bible or being a light at all. We've been so divorced from our first century Hebraic heritage and the culture and the context. We've been so infused with anti-Semitism against modern state of Israel today. It's affecting how we actually look at the scriptures, forgetting that Jesus was a Jew. The New Testament authors were Jewish. The entire Bible is written from a Hebraic perspective. Antisemitism has no place in society, period, much less inside of biblical hermeneutics or interpretation of the scriptures themselves. And when we allow modern-day dogma and liberal agendas to pierce the heart of the church and to lock the door behind us, they will light it on fire and burn us alive inside. And that's what's happening, in my opinion. We are moving away from the image of God. We're moving away from the only manual that God ever gave us in the front of the book, the Torah, that sets up the back of the book with the new covenant. The two are supposed to work together.

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That's why [Jeremiah 31](#) says that I'm putting before you a new covenant, not with the house of Israel and the house of Judah like it was in the past, but I'm going to give you one that I'm going to write the Torah on your heart. There's no house of Gentile. We are part of Israel. We can't be antisemitic against ourselves. We're connected to the Jewish people whether you like it or not. This is all part of a larger scheme that God is working out. And the Torah is the central focal point of all of it, all of the spokes of the New Testament, all of its theology. Literally, it says in Timothy that all Scripture is God-breathed, worthy for correction, reproof, and ways of righteousness. In the first century when that was written, there's no New Testament. All Scripture was the front of the book. It was the Torah, the Tanakh, the Prophets, what we call the Old Testament. And they called it *all* doctrine should be formed from that. There's not a pastor I know that believes that, but it's written right in the New Testament. The image of God is more important than ever right now. And if we don't know these things, we can't apply these things. If we don't apply these things, we will be deceived by those things. So, at the end, the book of Revelation is not given to us so that we live in fear of the future. And so many people study it from that angle. No, God has not given us a spirit of fear, but a spirit of power, love, and a sound mind. Sound minds that we are not going to be susceptible to the virus that the enemy has that's coming and already here. No, we were given the book of Revelation so that we would remain faithful in the present. John doesn't tell us and tell the churches to panic, to decode timelines, or to hunt for villains. He tells us to endure, to refuse false worship, and to keep our allegiance clear.

AI doesn't change the heart of Revelation's warning. It only explains how ancient patterns will operate at global scale today. The danger has never been technology. If you believe that AI is evil, you're misguided. AI is not the problem. No more than a sword or a gun is the problem. It's who's holding it. It's the one that's pulling the trigger. It's the authority behind it. The danger has always been loving comfort more than faithfulness, security more than obedience, and participation more than truth. The day is coming when your faith is going to be challenged, and all of what you're going through today is simply training for the real challenges that are coming ahead. Because all of us are eating, all of us are drinking, all of us are enjoying life to whatever degree, but the moment is going to come when the switch is turned off and you cannot eat. Who will you serve? Yeshua didn't go into the desert for 40 days to start His ministry for nothing, not eating anything and being tested three times by the beast dragon Himself. And food was at the center of that. Worship was at the center of that. Trust and faithfulness under pressure is what God is looking for.

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So, the good news is this, the same scriptures that warn us about Babylon and the beast also promise that it falls. The beast is judged and the lamb wins. Amen. The goal is not to survive the end times by being clever, but to overcome by being faithful. Some people say, God is mean if He lets you go through the Great Tribulation and you get hit by a hundred-pound hailstone. First, if you get hit by a 100-pound hailstone, you're not even going to know it. You'll just be with Him in the air. You'll be at least waiting for Him to come in the air. But at the end of the day, it doesn't matter. It's not about our physical bodies. It's not about whether we make it or don't make it or prepare enough and have enough pallets of food or enough ammunition to make it. It's not about making it. It's not about surviving. It's about being faithful in the moment.

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Someone needs to say amen out loud and write it in the comments. It's about being faithful under pressure. The church is being groomed that they need to prepare for the great tribulation with flashlights and batteries and freeze-dried food. And that's great. And I'm not saying don't do that. I think that is actually important. I have all of those things. But at the end of the day, it's not what I'm trusting in. And if it fails me horribly, it's okay. Because God is not concerned about this right here. He's not concerned about my flesh. He's not concerned about how I feel. He's concerned about giving me the greatest reward He could possibly give me. And He knows I've got to get the flesh out and I've got to earn it. I need to qualify to enter the promised land. I don't just get it for free. He doesn't just hand out the greatest in the kingdom out of a lottery. He hands it to those who keep His commandments and are faithful to the end. It's not talking about anything other than faith under pressure is the only evidence to prove that you know and love Him. This is what He's looking for.

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So, in the end, let it be like the beginning, except for let us turn to that serpent in the tree looking at us with this double forked tongue out, which is exactly what the false prophet will be. One tongue will be to serve God, and one side will be to serve man. And most, because they don't know the word, will fall for it, and that will be the great deception. Let us look at the serpent and tell him no now, and he will flee and will bother everybody else. The only way to make it to the end is to resist the serpent under pressure when it shows up. And that means everything that you're going through right now, everything that you're going through right now is training.
